

# Call for applications for n. 3 scholarships for participation to: GPIIP – STARTING A GRANT PROPOSAL THE VALUE OF INTERDISCIPLINARITY IN GRANT WRITING

## 1. General Rules

To encourage participation to GPIIP – STARTING A GRANT PROPOSAL THE VALUE OF INTERDISCIPLINARITY IN GRANT WRITING Summer School the Organizing Committee is announcing a "Call for Scholarship" for a minimum of 3 grants aimed on covering travel and accommodation costs of selected summer school participants.

## 2. Details concerning the grants

Each grant is worth:

- Full fee waiving for Summer School Participation
- A maximum of € 500,00 for EU candidates and € 1,000 for extra-EU candidates depending on the expenses estimated during the application process.

The Scientific Committee reserves the right to award additional scholarships to cover total or partial expenses based on fund availability.

## 3. Eligibility requirements

Application is open to early-stage researchers and late-stage master students students across all disciplines.

## 4. How to apply

Candidates may only apply online using the application available on the [University website](#).

All the documentation accompanying the application must be submitted exclusively online in PDF format (one file only) and must be written in English.

Applications must be accompanied by the following documents (in PDF format and unique file and in English).

- a detailed CV ("curriculum of educational and work experience");
- one copy of a currently valid identification document;
- a motivation letter, where the candidate should indicate her/his main scope of the summer school abroad (max 1 page);
- an estimation of the expenses for travel and accommodation to the Summer School.

## 5. Closing date for presentation of the application

Candidates' applications, complete with the accompanying documentation, must be delivered online no later than **September 1, 2023** following the procedure indicated on the website. When this time limit is reached, the online application procedure will be disabled.

## **6. Scientific Committee and Selection Process**

The recipients of the grants must produce original and copies of all payments receipts via (failure to do so may result in reduction of the grant), no later than 30 days after the completion of the school.
